



Parking lot base, cars, patio furniture and fence not included

This kit includes all building parts laser cut in white acrylic, clear acrylic window glazing, self-adhesive microplywood, Evergreen styrene strips and Plastruct corrugated roofing. All parts fit together but may need light sanding in joints for cosmetic reasons. The model needs painting.

Some model building and painting skills are required.




Assembly instructions for Tractor Supply kit

Thank you for buying this modern Tractor Supply store kit. Please take some time to read these instructions before you begin assembling.

This kit is laser cut in acrylic and self-adhesive micro-plywood and is very easy to glue together using MicroMark Samestuff or Plastruct Plastic Weld glue. The wall parts are tabbed and slotted for easier assembly.

Take your time to identify all parts, lay them out as on the pictures and clean them for any burrs before you start gluing them together.


Handle the acrylic parts with care; they are easier breakable than the usual styrene parts.



Before you begin assembling:


Also included: Evergreen 5-110, pack of 50 styrene strips for roof joints

Street sign and building sign parts





Use the Awning Template to cut the 2 awnings from the Plastruct sheet. Break the wall brackets out of the sprue and clean them as shown.






Using the BACKSIDE of the front wall, mount the brackets WITHOUT gluing. Hold the awning in place with a piece of masking tape, then glue the brackets to the awning.



When the glue has set, remove the awnings and put them aside for later

Assembly:


Mount the side walls of the entrance to the front wall, then glue the entrance front on, aligning the tabs and slots.



Glue the side wall to the front and continue with the other side wall. Glue the front floor frame to the inside of the walls.




Line the rear floor frame up with the rear corners and keep them in place with the joint plates as shown.




Glue on the rear wall and the roof support as shown.




Glue the inside roof support walls to the front wall on both sides. Glue the styrene strips into the grooves of the roof pieces.







Glue the small roofs to the entrance, then glue the soffit pieces to the edges of the roof.




Laminate the 3 street sign pieces, when the glue has set, insert the tap into the styrene tube. Be careful not the break the tab.

Painting & finishing:






Brush paint the red band around the building and the soffits on the entrance. Glue the 2 large roof pieces onto the walls




Mask off the red stripe and soffits and spray the entire building with gray primer. When the primer has dried, spray all the walls and the columns on the entrance light gray.

Mask off the entire walls except the lower 6 brick rows. Paint these light brown (Earth)




Mask off the walls and columns around the entrance and paint the grooved upper walls aluminum,



Also paint the entire roof aluminum as well as the door frame and roll up gate.

Paint the self-adhesive wood strips red.





Stick the red wood strips to the entrance as shown, starting with the sides.





Before you handle the decals, spray them with a coat of Krylon clear acrylic or Testors Dullcote to protect the print.

Cut them out using a steel ruler and a sharp hobby knife. Stick the logo decal onto the front sign and paint the edge of the paper and sign with a black Sharpie.





Mask off the face of the street sign and spray it black




Stick the self-adhesive decals to both sides of the sign





Glue the door glass and rear gate glass to the inside of the wall.





Stick the self-adhesive door frame to the glass. Mount the awnings and secure them with a drop of glue from the inside





You can strengthen the roof by adding 1x1 mm (0.040") styrene strips as shown (not included)



Glue the front sign on with Woodland Scenics Scenic Glue, it dries up clear and flat.


